
#### Conditions:

- 2. This approval requires compliance with the procedures specified in the approved continuing airworthiness management organisation exposition, and
- This approval does not constitute an authorization to operate the types of aircraft listed in the approval schedule. The authorization to operate the aircraft is the Air Operator Certificate (AOC).
- 4. This approval is limited to the aircraft registrations specified in the AOC.
- This approval is valid whilst the operator remains in compliance with Part-M Section A Subpart G and that the applicable Aircraft Maintenance Programme, MEL and aircraft Technical Log System remain approved.
- 6. Subject to compliance with the foregoing conditions, this approval shall remain valid unless the approval has previously been surrendered, superseded, suspended or revoked.
- Where the technical services organisation is different to the operator, this approval remains valid subject to such organisation(s) fulfilling applicable contractual obligations.
- 8. Termination, suspension or revocation of the AOC automatically invalidates the present approval.
